





EDCF(1)





- Since 1987, EDCF has committed KRW 16 trillion (≒ US\$ 15 billion) to 54 countries with 395 projects.
- Joining OECD DAC(Development Assistance Committee) in 2010, a sharp increase in EDCF volume.











- Asia is the largest partner but steadily increasing projects in other region.
- EDCF focus on infrastructure projects including transportation and water and sanitation area.






Global Network

Loan Amount

Currency

Korea won (or USD, Euro in co-financing)



Interest Rate / Repayment (grace period)


- General: 0.05-2.50% / up to 40 years (15 years)
- **Preferential:** 0.01-2.00% / up to 40 years (15 years)
- Special: 0% / up to 40 years (15 years)


